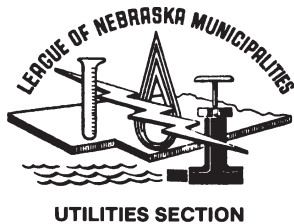

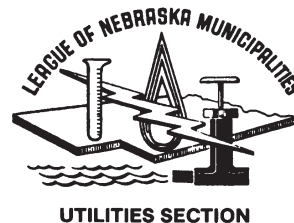

**About the school**

The *Nebraska Meter Conference* is sponsored annually by the *League of Nebraska Municipalities Utilities Section* in cooperation with the *Nebraska Rural Electric Association*. Each year, we feature the major manufacturers and local area electrical representatives who instruct on electric metering, troubleshooting and the industry's latest technologies.

The school will consist of concurrent sessions for both days. The presentations will highlight software technologies, installation procedures, safety practices, billing and related smart metering capabilities. Both days will feature these meter companies and related electrical companies to provide a well-rounded educational school no matter what electric meter or software package your municipality or rural public power district uses.

**Who should attend**

The Nebraska Meter Conference is for all electric meter technicians or line worker/technicians who are dedicated to the metering industry and would like to further their knowledge in order to keep in stride with the rapidly changing technology that is challenging both apprentice and expert technicians.
