### **MEMORANDUM**

**DATE:** April 19, 2021

**SUBJECT:** Rubber Gloving School – May 25-27, 2021

Northeast Community College is committed to assisting in minimizing the risk of COVID-19 to our students, visitors, and employees. ### **Tentative Program:**

### **Beginners:**

The beginner's section is for those individuals with very little exposure/experience. This section will cover the basics of rubber gloving and line work.

### **Discussion Points:**

Importance of a job briefing, and complete one for each new job during this training

Proper care of equipment and cover-up

The amount of cover-up needed for different jobs

Selection of tools and cover-up for the job

Inspection of equipment (includes PPE)

Truck inspection

Truck positioning and set-up

Proper grounding of trucks/equipment

Use of an extend-o stick/shotgun

Use of wrap locks/armor rod/ties

Other basic line work

### Work/Jobs

Insulator change out (pole top and cross-arm)

Cross-arm change out on single phase

Bell change out on single phase dead-ends (pole and arm)

Single phase pole change-out

Changing out a transformer on an energized pole

### Intermediate:

This section is for those individuals who have experience, rubber gloving. They will cover situations that utilities deal with on a day to day basis. This group will be discussing different ways to do a job and then decide on the best method that will apply in their particular situation.

### **Discussion Points:**

Complete a job briefing form for each new job

### Work/Jobs

Change out a cutout and an arrester that are mounted on a riser pole, keeping the primary underground energized

Cut-in/cut-out bells on T-2 conductor

Classroom on electrical apparatus (Topic TBD)

Cut-in/cut-out a C-8 structure

Change out crossarms on different structures energized

### **Advanced:**

This section is for those individuals who have extensive experience in rubber gloving. They will be performing tasks that aren't routine. They will use their experience and knowledge to "think outside of the box" on more complex jobs and decide on the safest and best method to perform the task at hand.

Change out a C-7/C-7 structure energized

Change out an angle double dead-end pole energized

Change out a C-4 structure energized
